Javier Diez Canseco, former Peruvian Senator who led the Senate investigations into the Accomarca Massacre as well as other investigations of human rights abuses committed during former President Alberto Fujimori's term.

Eduardo Gonzalez, Americas Deputy Director of the International Center for Transitional Justice and a core staff member of the Peruvian Truth and Reconciliation Commission.
